Supervised (or “Accompanied”) Visits

\$100/hour for visits and consultations with other professionals regarding the visits (attorneys, parenting coordinator, mental health professionals, etc.).

\$150/hour for court preparation and testimony at hearings (billed to party requiring my appearance).

An additional quarter hour (15 minutes) is billed for each visit for scheduling and note preparation.

Supervised (or “Accompanied”) Exchanges

(offered as standalone service if visit is not required to be supervised):

\$100 per two exchanges, \$175 for four exchanges, \$250 for six exchanges.

Available weekdays and weekends; flexible hours, subject to availability. Supervisor will communicate and coordinate dates/times/locations with the parents. Visit notes and a transcript of text communications for scheduling are provided. Photos and videos may be provided.

Accepted on case-by-case basis, depending on reason for supervision and track record of successful visits or exchanges.

Fee is due at or before scheduled visit, exchange, or court appearance.

Venmo, Apple Pay, Zelle, CashApp, cash, credit cards** accepted (no checks or PayPal).

All fees are based on preferred locations: Veteran’s Memorial Park or Durbin Pavilion shopping area, in St. Johns, Florida. 24-hour notice of cancellation is required to avoid a fee. The parent cancelling a visit within 24-hours is responsible for the entire visit fee. If the visit is not accomplished due to the child’s refusal, the custodial parent will be charged the entire visit fee (treated as a cancellation by the custodial parent). Travel time will be charged for visits and exchanges outside of preferred locations and for in-person court appearances.

Other possible visitation sites: zoo, restaurant, beach, kids’ athletic practice/games, Target (or other shopping location), Top Golf, Town Center, other parks, parent’s, or relative’s home.

The supervisor does not choose the location of the visit. If the visit is not occurring at one of the preferred locations, the visit will occur at a mutually agreeable location, or a location ordered by the Court. If the parents cannot agree on a location, it will occur at one of the preferred locations.

Services must be agreed upon by parties/attorneys or court ordered. If a restraining order or injunction is in place, it is the parties’ responsibility to remain the required distance apart.

** a service charge will apply if I process your credit card through Square. You may use your credit card through ApplePay, CashApp, or Venmo to avoid these charges.
